## ACCESS APPROVAL -COLD LAKE AIR WEAPONS RANGE (CLAWR)

- 1. 4 Wing approves CLFN access to the CLAWR within the green and purple zones indicated on Figure 1 below from 1800 hours on 06 November 2020 until 0700 hours on 09 November 2020. The CLFN members will be allowed to travel within 100 Meters of the Lake shore to expedite access to the Purple area. Please note that hunting is not permitted within the purple zone for safety reasons, and access to Primrose Lake will only be allowed on weekends and designated Holidays. Due to the unfortunate loss of an aircraft and a member of 4 Wing, a 3 square mile box (see para e.) around the crash site is off limits to all personnel. The access area boundaries are outlined by the coordinates below:
