

## Cold Lake First Nation Treaty Days July 12-14, 2019 SECURITY Application Form

Cold Lake First Nations Treaty Day Committee is seeking 36 positions beginning Friday, July 12, 2019 to Sunday, July 14, 2019 for the positions for SECURITY for the 2019 CLFN Treaty Days being held July 12-14 at English Bay Treaty Grounds 149B.

Duties include but not limited to: inspection of vehicles, manning entry/exit gates, enforce the rules and regulations set forth by the Treaty Day Committee and Authorized by Chief and Council: "NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS!! 1) No violence or abuse; 2) No firearms or weapons permitted; 3) Swimming curfew of 8:30pm sharp and quiet hour from 2am-6am; 4) No dogs or livestock (ex. Horses); 5) For your safety, please refrain from drinking the lake water; 6) No quads, trikes or motorbikes permitted on-site (with the exception of security vehicles); 7) No speeding. Speed limit 15km/hr; 8) Park in designated areas; 9) RV parking in designated areas only. You will be advised where to park if this applies to you; 10) Swimming and water sport activities are at visitors own risk!; 11) Concessions permits must be displayed; 12) Entry fees for competition/ events must paid in advance; 13) Children must be supervised by parents/ guardians at all times; 14) No 50/50 draws, raffles or people selling for personal gain; 15) Cold Lake First Nations and Treaty Days Committee and/ or designates assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items. Damaged items during this event are strictly at your own risk! Anyone that refuses to abide by these rules and regulations will be asked to leave the premises".
